

The New Research Method on the Reference to Zhe &Suo in ShiJi

Abstract In Classic Chinese a non-noun phrase may change to a noun phrase in certain environments. That process is referred to as nominalization. Chinese has no inflection, is a kind of isolating languages, however, Classic Chinese also can change into nominal element with some empty words, just like *Zhe & Suo*. We combine the theory of *self-designation* and *transferred-designation*, with the data-base based on *Microsofe Access*, can review and analyse the phenomena of *Zhe & Suo* in the *BenJi & LieZhuang* of *ShiJi*.
